### **Balint Intensive Workshop in Auckland**

The BSA, in conjunction with the Goodfellow Unit, Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences, Auckland University, presented a Balint Leadership Intensive Workshop in Auckland from 17th to 20th June, 2010.

Leaders who attended from overseas were John Salinsky, Lenka Speight and Shake Seigel from UK, and Ann Sinclair and Don Nease from USA. This was an excellent opportunity to broaden professional contacts and meet members of the international Balint community, and many new professional and personal connections were made.

There were 32 attendees from New Zealand and 23 from Australia.

The Intensive ran very smoothly overall and was a valuable time for furthering Balint work and interactions for the participants. Several workshops were also run during the course of the Intensive, including discussion in relation to possible future structures of Balint connection between Australia and New Zealand.

Many thanks must be extended to the organizing committee, and especially Peter Huggard of the Goodfellow Unit at University of Auckland, and John Barton and Penny Love based in Australia. These events require a significant amount of work and attention to detail, and the smoothness of the arrangements during the Intensive were testament to how well this was performed.

**New Zealand News** The BSA Leadership Intensive in Auckland in June 2010 was attended by 32 New Zealanders including 18 GPs.

A week later several leaders who had been at the Intensive presented Balint work at the RNZCGP Medical Educators Convention.

It has been exciting to know that the effect of these two events on the interest in NZ in ongoing Balint work has been considerable. New Balint groups for GPs have started in Wellington and Auckland with planning for others in Dunedin, Hamilton and Hawkes Bay. The NZ Institute for Rural Health is funding a Balint group by teleconference for Remote rural GPs. One Balint group for GP registrars has begun and several GP teachers are using the Balint method. Other initiatives include Balint groups for Psychiatric registrars, in a hospice, with PGY2 doctors. There are ongoing groups in Christchurch, Auckland and Nelson.

**Australian Balint in China** Leonie Sullivan and Laurie Lovell-Simons submitted a proposal to run a Balint Workshop at the first International Psychoanalysis Association Conference in Asia, "Freud in Asia". The proposal was accepted and 23, mostly Chinese, clinicians attended. The workshop was conducted with a translator. The feedback was very positive. It was very exciting to use the Balint model in a cross cultural and cross language setting at such a significant international event.
